Our recent ministry trip to Uganda began on May 9 and concluded May 30th. We stayed in the home of FFCM Directors Cyprian and Margaret Masembe and their 4 children. The children were on school break so it was a great time spent with the whole family. We especially enjoyed being part of a "Family Alter" each evening with singing and dancing praises to our God, prayer, scripture reading and discussion.

We attended 35 ministry events and taught and/or preached 30 times. We visited 7 of the 9 FFCM Churches and hosted leaders from all 9 churches at the FFCM Bible Institute in Madudu Village.

We secured a prime location in a new building on the main road through Mukono for an FFCM Office and new Bridal Shop. Building is under construction and will be ready to occupy in October.

We also visited a new area for us, the city of Mbale where we attended open air evangelistic outreaches, preached and taught at Calvary Temple Mbale. Calvary Temple is pastored by our friends Mike and Millie Mataya. We also helped to Baptize 40 new believers, many from Muslim backgrounds.
